Charles and Tommye began serving NMCCH as House Parents in 1972. One year later, Charles was promoted to Assistant Executive Director. In 1979, Charles established the Christian Child Placement Service, the only private Christian adoption agency in New Mexico. He directed the placement of hundreds of babies into adoptive homes. Tommye

managed our Donor Accounts, bringing us into the computer age with her professionalism.

During their careers at the Home, Charles and Tommye were awarded the J.W. Terry Founders Award for their many years of service! In 2000, Charles also received the Distinguished Service Award from the Christian Child and Family Services Association!

On September 11, 2001, Charles was visiting Washington D.C. to receive the U.S. Congressional Award, "Angel in Adoptions." That day he witnessed, firsthand, the burning Pentagon after terrorists flew a passenger airplane into the building.

Charles began serving as the Executive Director of NMCCH in 2001. During the next ten years he continued to expand our facilities and services. Charles and Tommye leave behind a legacy that is second to none in leadership and child care service.
